of resources no dearth

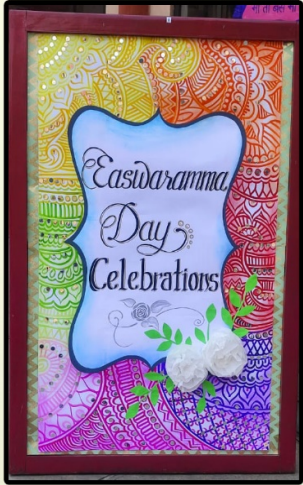
And with her able guidance, our Lord

And we be in her laps



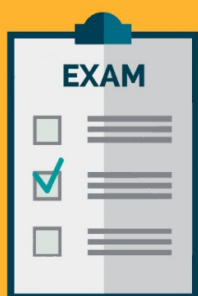


BOREDOM AND BOARDS!

THE BIG BANG OF ACADEMIC YEAR



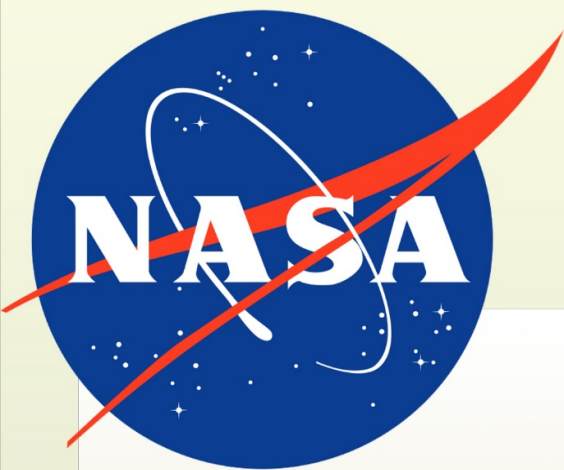

PLANNING ON ORDERING FOOD?

NASA CAN HELP WITH DELIVERY FROM SPACE!



A NASA plant experiment, which consisted of growing and harvesting chili peppers in space, broke a record for feeding the most astronauts from a crop grown in space. The experiment also made history as the longest one to take place on the International Space Station (ISS) "Growing colorful vegetables in space can have long-term benefits for physical and psychological health," Matt Romeyn, a plant scientist at NASA, said in a press release this summer. "We are discovering that growing plants and vegetables with colors and smells helps to improve astronauts' well-being." Astronauts grew green chile on the space station and made space tacos. It's NASA's first time growing peppers in space. And after they were harvested, NASA astronauts got to sample the crop sprinkled on tacos at the International Space Station.

Who knows, one day the space center could be the go-to spot for food enthusiasts who like their food with a view!
