# Model United Nations Conference

On 23 August 2022, Lancarians performed unprecedentedly in the International Hindi Olympiad organized by Hindi Vikas Sansthan. Out of the participating students, 28 bagged the Gold Medal, 51 got Silver Medal and 66 got Bronze Medal. On December 9, Teen Murti Bahavan's auditorium echoed with applause when our school was acknowledged with "International Hindi Unnayak Samman 2022" in the International Hindi Samman Ceremony-2022 organized by Hindi Vikas Sansthan. Along with this, five meritorious and talented students of the school were honored with National Hindi Pratibha Samman and two other students with Hindi Bal Shreshtha Samman (at state level). Two students who topped the merit list were appreciated with monetary reward. The Hindi HOD and teacher Dr. Manishi Sharma was given the National Hindi Prerak Samman.
